COMMUNITY EXTENSION UPDATES

The months of July and August seemed to be very hectic for the Community Extension Office of the school. Both Angela Hills and the Kasanag Village at Abada Escay received several programs rendered by the various departments of Riverside College.

At Kasanag Village, a Team Building and Leadership Seminar for the mothers was rendered and this was followed by an Organizational Mechanics Session for the Kasanag United Mothers Association. These mothers also received Health Education Sessions from the Level 2 Clinical Instructors as well as the Master in Nursing students on separate occasions.

On the other hand, the College of Arts and Sciences Faculty is now on its 2nd year of implementation of the CYDP (Child and Youth Development Program) with the kids at Kasanag Village. The Math and Science instructors rendered Health Education, Blood Typing and Stool Examination to the kids last July while for the month of August, the English and Filipino instructors enhanced the oral communication skills of the children and youth in that village.



In addition, a Coordination Meeting with the Principal of Vista Alegre Granada Relocation Elementary School was conducted recently regarding the "Tree Planting" activity of the NSTP students and faculty. They will also be launching the "Piso Mo Para Sa Kalusugan Ko" project before the semester ends.

At Angela Hills, weighing of children for the Nutrition program was conducted. The "Limpyo Ugsaran" project of the Campus Ministry and Religious Education volunteers last July was also a success. The project culminated with a Feeding session for almost 200 children.
